Dear Parents,

'One Voice One Love' Concert Thursday 6th July



As you may be aware through the local press coverage we will be hosting a charity event at Tarleton Academy on Thursday 6th July, from 7.00pm-10.00pm, in aid of the families of Georgina and Saffie. The money raised will also be used for the development of a memorial on the Tarleton Community Primary School and Runshaw College sites.

This event is about raising money but at the same time providing a fun concert for the community to enjoy. The event is an outdoor concert that will be using part of the Academy site at the rear of the sportshall and brings together a number of professional companies and artists

giving up their time free of charge. Tickets for the concert have been sold through the local primary schools and Runshaw College, in the first instance, and a small number went on general sale through 'Kiddiroo' in the village. We are pleased to say the concert is now a sell out! Please note there will be no entry without a wristband ticket.

Due to the security required for the event on Thursday 6th June all extra-curricular clubs will finish at 4.15pm so students and staff will be able to leave the premises by 4.30pm. During the event there will be no parking on the school site except for blue badge holders. Endeavour Swimming lesson will run as normal with access for parking checked at the barrier. If you have tickets for the event the gates will open at 6.00pm. Please be aware of the following posted on the 'One Voice One Love' Facebook page www.facebook.com/onevoiceoneloove;

'...no bags will be allowed on site. If you need to bring items to the event they will need to be in a CLEAR plastic bag. You will be able to pick up a FREE clear bag from Kiddiroo from Saturday 1st July. Small umbrellas will be allowed, if needed, but large golf umbrellas will not be permitted. Due to the security checks that will be made on the night we are advising people to arrive in plenty of time. To help with this we are bringing the gate opening time forward to 6.00pm. If you are a blue badge holder you will need to email your car number plate and the numbers on your ticket wristband to enquiries@kiddiroo.co.uk prior to the event. The event will be held outside and although this will be a standing event we will be allowing people to bring fold up chairs. Food and drink will be available to purchase on the night. Tarleton Academy is a no smoking venue - the smoking of electronic cigarettes is also not permitted on site. Please keep checking this page for up-to-date information. We hope everyone has an amazing night!'
